2. Case 77396: College Decision 185/17/COL - Letter of formal notice - Support for studies abroad for migrant and frontier workers and their family members in Norway

The College adopted a Decision to issue a letter of formal notice to Norway that by requiring that migrant and frontier workers, and dependent family members, comply with requirements such as those laid down in Section 31 5 of the Study Financing Regulation, in order to be eligible for study

financing abroad, Norway has failed to fulfil its obligations arising from Article 28 of the EEA Agreement and from Article 7(2) of the Act referred to at point 2 of Annex V (Regulation (EU) No 492/2011 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 5 April 2011 on freedom of movement for workers within the Union), as adapted to the EEA Agreement by Protocol 1 thereto, as Decision No. 185/17/COL.
