2. Case 81070: College Decision 050/18/COL- Closure Decision - Complaint against Norway regarding Re-use of public sector information (PSI Directive)

The College adopted a Decision to close a complaint case arising from an alleged failure by the Norwegian West Police District to comply with Directive 2003/98/EC on the re-use of public sector information, by rejecting a request for a grant of access to information and by the lack of response to enquiries, as Decision No. 050/18/COL.

3. Case 69544: College Decision 051/18/COL - Closure Decision - Complaint against Norway concerning compliance with the Water Framework Directive 2000/60 as regards regulated water courses

4. Case 73930: College Decision 052/18/COL - Closure Decision - Complaints against Norway concerning family reunification rights of EEA nationals and returning Norwegian nationals

The College adopted a Decision to close complaint cases No 73930, 74207, 74690, 75109, 75148, 75230, 75352, 75353, 75500, 75862, 76027, 76115, 76284, 77679, 77724, 77940, 79394 and 79433 arising from the failure by Norway to comply with its obligations under Articles 28, 31 and 36 EEA and Directive 2004/38/EC by not ensuring fully the derived rights of family members of EEA nationals and Norwegian nationals who have exercised their free movement rights under EEA law, as Decision No. 052/18/COL.

5. Case 76523: College Decision 049/18/COL - Closure Decision - Conformity assessment on the implementation of Directive 2008/104/EC on temporary agency work in Liechtenstein
