The Parliamentary Decision amends the Energy Act of 29 June 1990 No 50 (Energiloven).</p> <p>-Agreement (Avtalen) between Enova and the Ministry of Oil and Energy, on the management of the funds derived from the Energy Fund, during the period between January the 1st 2017 to December the 31st 20202. On the 1st May 2018 the ownership of Enova (and the Agreement) was transferred from the Ministry of Oil and Energy to the Ministry of Climate and Environment.</p>
